The Opportunity

Talon Metals Corp is recruiting for a Geophysical Surveyor – Assistant to join the Tamarack Project team in Tamarack, Minnesota, USA. The Tamarack Project is focused on developing high grade nickel sulphide mineralization in the Main Zone of the Tamarack Intrusive Complex associated with the 1.1 Ga Midcontinent Rifting event.

This is an entry level position with opportunity to grow into increasingly senior roles over time.

What the role entails

The Geophysical Surveyor - Assistant will display a strong work ethic contributing towards team-oriented productivity, while working in a safe and responsible manner.

Reporting to the Geophysical Surveyor Team Leader, duties include, but are not limited to:

- Safety is the priority. Be able to identify hazards in the work area and remove them before beginning a task so that no one is injured.
- Assist in all aspects of geophysical data collection in the field. For example:
 - o Carrying up to 50 or more pounds of survey equipment through the bush off trail.
 - Using a compass and GPS to navigate while installing geophysical sensors in the bush.
 - Driving a pickup truck or a UTV
 - o Working outside every day in Northern Minnesota during all seasons and all weather (rain, snow, extreme heat, extreme cold).

What you will need for this role

- Bachelor's Degree in Geophysics or Geology is required
- 0-1 years of related work experience
- Strong commitment to workplace safety
- Strong communication skills, both written and verbal

- Be self-motivated and able to complete job duties with minimal supervision.
- Enjoy working in a team, but have ability to work independently
- Strong computer skills and familiarity with software operating systems
