The Opportunity

Talon Metals Corp is recruiting for a Senior Project Geologist to join the Tamarack Project team in Tamarack, Minnesota, USA. The Tamarack Project is focused on developing high grade nickel sulfide mineralization in the Main Zone of the Tamarack Intrusive Complex associated with the 1.1 Ga Midcontinent Rifting event.

What the role entails

This is a great opportunity for an experienced core logging Geologist to lead the core shed staff in processing and interpreting exploration drill core from the Tamarack Intrusive Complex.

Reporting to the Head of Exploration duties include, but are not limited to:

- Follow and uphold company policies and procedures including health, safety, and environmental regulations throughout all assigned tasks.
- Organize and direct all tasks related to collecting data from diamond drill core including geological logging, geotechnical logging, assay sampling, and core cutting.
- Assist in maintaining all geological data in an acQuire database.
- Ensure quality assurance standards are met, and quality control processes are applied to all data sets.
- Actively participate in core logging.
- Assist the project team in analysis and interpretation of drill core and the Tamarack geological model.
- Be willing and able to complete other tasks as necessary.

What you will need for this role

To succeed in this role, you will have/be:

- Bachelor of Science in Geology is required
- Master of Science in Geology or closely related field is preferred
- Magmatic nickel experience is preferred, but not required
- 5-10 years diamond drill core logging experience is required
- Proficiency in Seequent Leapfrog Geo, Acquire, MS Excel, ESRI ArcGIS preferred
- Experience managing small teams in collection of geological data

- Enjoy working in a team, but have ability to work independently
- Be self-motivated and able to complete job duties with minimal supervision
- Be able to lift and carry core boxes and sample bags (50 pounds or more)
- Be able to stand for extended periods of time throughout the day
- Have a valid Driver's License with a clean driving record
- Valid First Aid certification is preferred
- Willingness to work weekends and irregular schedules.
