This internship provides students with first-hand experience in a variety of career paths across the mineral exploration industry. The program can be customized to fit the interests of the student.

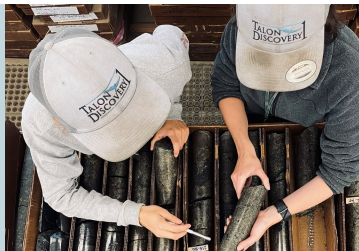
